Mississippi Chief Fire Officer Designation Program

Purpose

The purpose of this program is to provide an established set of standards for Chief Fire Officer of fire departments in the State of Mississippi.

What It Is

Beginning January 1, 2009, the Mississippi Fire Chiefs Association made available the designation of **Mississippi Chief Fire Officer**. The opportunity to receive the designation of **Mississippi Chief Fire Officer** shall be made available to those who demonstrate:

- their willingness to promote and support the Mississippi fire service
- the established knowledge, skills, and ability expected of a Mississippi Chief Fire Officer

The following designation levels are available:

- Level I
- Level II
- Level III

All levels require a valid Mississippi driver's license, high school diploma, a minimum of 5 years of fire service experience, and current membership in the Mississippi Fire Chiefs Association. All candidates must also meet ethical, moral, and professional expectations.

Who Is Eligible?

<u>This designation is available to personnel who currently serve in positions such as Deputy Chief,</u> <u>Assistant Chief, Training Chief, District Chief, etc.</u> This designation is available to Career, Combination, and Volunteer personnel.

What Steps are Required to Become a designated Mississippi Chief Fire Officer?

- 1. Obtain an application:
 - a. From the MFCA website
 - b. From the Mississippi State Fire Academy website
 - c. Contact the Chief Fire Officer Program Coordinator @ 601-932-2444
- 2. Complete the application and forward it to the Chief Fire Officer Program Coordinator.
 - a. All applicable documents must be included.
 - b. There is a \$25.00 fee, payable to Mississippi Fire Chiefs Association.
 - c. Applications will be processed on a monthly basis.
- 3. <u>Designation certificates will be presented at the annual summer conference</u>. <u>All applications</u> <u>must be received prior to May 1st annually before MS Chiefs Conference</u>.
- 4. <u>Your designation is valid for a 2-year period and must be renewed **before** the end of the 2-year period.</u>
